Anastasia Rizikov wins first prize in Concurso Internacional de Piano Rotary

—In Palma de Mallorca, Spain

What is even more spectacular is that Anastasia **won it in the Senior Division** (17 to 28 years old). Her grandmother/teacher, Maia Spis—the only teacher Anastasia has had thus far in her budding career—advised against such a move. Anastasia, however, feeling she was up to the competition, insisted on pulling out all the stops and giving it a try. After the first round (a 20-minute performance), she passed to the second round (a 40-minute performance), and then to the third round (a 30-minute performance) ... and **SHE WON!**

Not only was Anastasia Rizikov the first ever in the 28-year history of this prestigious competition to compete in the Senior Division **at age 12**, she was the **youngest competitor ever** in either division.

Along with prize money, Anastasia was awarded a concert tour of Spain and a performance with the Baleares Symphony Orchestra in Mallorca.
